# 11<sup>TH</sup> EUROPEAN GSE / IBM TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY FOR Z/VSE, Z/VM, KVM AND LINUX ON IBM Z SYSTEMS, HAMBURG / GERMANY, 23-25 OCTOBER 2017

The Technical University was held in the Hanseatic City of Hamburg, Germany, situated on the river Elbe; with about 1.8 Million people the second largest city of Germany. Hamburg is well known for its attractive culture, such as theatres, musicals, historical buildings and events. The objective of this European event is to offer a forum to IT Managers, Technical System Professionals and Application Developers, to learn from, provide and share with each other, their own experience reports, as well as hear from IBM and its partners about new developments and solutions. GSE and IBM offered first-hand information about technology evolution. The agenda covered new announcements, several international customer stories, IT optimization for enterprises and many other significant topics that reflected the potential of the platform to any z/VM, z/VSE, KVM and Linux on IBM z Systems IT Manager and IT Professional.



### GSE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (MAC), ROME / ITALY, 06-07 NOVEMBER 2017

GSE and IBM invited a selected group to attend the MAC at the IBM Software Center in Rome, one of the largest software development laboratories in Italy, and one of the largest IBM software group labs in Europe. During the 1,5 days, IT Managers and topical Specialists learned from IBM experts how to connect an existing backend mainframe to public cloud offerings and their concerns, security aspects and cost evaluations; the increasing nervousness around internal hacking/collusion that can destroy an organization's credibility. They also were able to get some advice on internal service security within the mainframe stack, as well as what the necessary skills and skill types from mainframe-cloud implementations are.
