The Technical University was held at the Westin Bellevue Hotel in Dresden, the capital of the Eastern German state of Saxony, distinguished by celebrated art museums and classic architecture of its reconstructed old town.

The objective of this European event was to offer a forum to IT Managers, Technical System Professionals and Application Developers. To learn from, provide and share with each other, their own experience reports, as well as hear from IBM and its partners about new developments and solutions.

People from all over the world (Austria, Bahrain, France, Germany, Israel, Italy, Norway, Spain, Switzerland, The Netherlands and USA) travelled to Dresden to attend the GSE / IBM event.

The recent years have brought many changes in the way how applications are developed and operated. Instead of running large monolithic applications, a more component driven approach is now state of the art. Workloads are put into containers, running isolated within one operating system, while defined APIs ensure that the ensemble of containers is working together. The task of infrastructure components and system operation now play the role of a conductor and orchestrator, defining and managing container environments. Building a bridge between both worlds easily and seamlessly is more and more the major task of IT. In 2018 many changes at IBM Z were introduced to satisfy these requirements, from a hardware (e.q. Z14 ZR1) and software (e.q. ICP, z/VM V7), so the motto this year was

"IBM Z and Virtualization as Bridge to the Future"
