Key parts of the conference were design discussions, sharing best practices, and to hear about upcoming development features.

**VIRTUAL 15<sup>TH</sup> GSE ISP SYMPOSIUM, 28 SEPTEMBER - 01 OCTOBER 2021**

It has been a very challenging project, involving many hours and people in organising the virtual edition of the ISP Symposium. We thank all the people involved in the organisation, our sponsors, vendors and speakers who made this unique event possible.

The conference was conducted with 2 tracks on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday and with 3 tracks on Thursday.

## GSE GUIDE AUTUMN EVENT NICE / FRANCE, 18-19 OCTOBER 2021

After 3 postponements of the **GSE GUIDE SPRING EVENT** we were very excited to finally be able to meet face-to-face at the newly refurbished Le Méridien Nice hotel.

The GSE GUIDE AUTUMN EVENT under the motto ““On the Wave of AI and Beyond” came up with a very attractive agenda, including live demonstrations on the autonomous ship MAYFLOWER, a ship crossing oceans autonomously without anyone on board or remote controlling. A “AI Captain” that leverages sensors data fusion to perceive its environment, think and decide at sea, without network connection. A flexible low-cost platform allowing scientists to collect more oceans vital data and to better understand key domains, such as pollution, marine mammals and global warming.

The first day ended with the demonstration of a productive AI solution, showing how to conclude an insurance policy by phone without any real person on the line.

The Guide Autumn Event closed on the second day with a panel discussion on autonomous and driverless vehicles.

We are convinced that the participants left with a lot of new impressions about current and future technologies.

15<sup>TH</sup> EUROPEAN GSE / IBM TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY FOR Z/VSE, Z/VM, KVM AND LINUX ON IBM Z, LEIPZIG / GERMANY, 25-27 OCTOBER 2021

The objective of this European event was to offer a forum to IT managers, technical system professionals and application developers to learn from each other, provide and share own experience reports, hear from IBM and its partners about new developments and solutions.

The balance and demand of enterprises' IT between efficiency, scalability, flexibility, security and reliability have been the premises guiding the IBM Z and LinuxONE platforms. Today most enterprises are thinking how to further optimize, simplify and integrate their IT by considering some kind (public, private or hybrid) of “cloud” deployment model, in terms of solutions at different abstraction layers, common within different platforms, to drive automation, agility with a similar user experience.

First-hand information was offered about technology evolution and on how advantages can be gained with IT. The agenda covered new announcements, several international customer stories, IT optimization, Cloud enablement topics for enterprise and many other significant topics that reflect the potential of the z/VM, z/VSE, KVM and Linux on IBM Z platform to IT managers and IT professionals.
